

It's hard to believe **Ash Wednesday** is only three weeks away, which means preparation for upcoming events, such as Fr. George's "Cinema Divina", our annual parish mission plus other related Lenten programs.

I always feel a bit of anxious during this time because of all the little details that are involved especially during Easter Week and then Easter weekend. The church in her glory always puts forth great effort in remembering the life of Christ, His Passion and His Resurrection.

As mentioned above, Fr. George is inviting us to come join him on February 12th at 1:00 for "Cinema Divina" in which he will present Bette Davis in the movie, "**The Star**". The movie takes place in the parish hall; the details of which will come soon.

And now for some more good news: the weekend after Ash Wednesday, Feb. 14th, Faith Formation presents our annual parish mission which will be presented and conducted by the **Dominican Friars of St. Albert's Priory in Oakland**. In addition to that, I am planning, along with the help of our music director and cantor, **two (2) Taizé meditation** and reconciliation services, more information is forthcoming.

**Bible study** will continue during the Lenten season, with the exception during Holy Week and one week after Easter. Again, more information will be available on the parish website.

And before parting ways, I would like to emphasize to all of us the importance of abstaining from certain foods and activities by making an effort to give up something and replacing with something else. If you are able please continue to give generously to the food bank and by donating gift cards to St. Vincent de Paul at St. Mary's. They greatly appreciate the many contributions our community has made over the last three years.

A prayerful exploration of a movie

Fr. George Da Roza

Come join me in the viewing and discussion of a 1952 black and white movie, "The Star" (90 mins), starring Bette Davis, Sterling Hayden, and a young Natalie Wood. The movie tells the story of a faded movie star and her desire to remain at the top of her game even when all indications show that it is unlikely to happen.

After the movie, we will discuss scriptural elements found in the subtext of the film, for example, how we choose to define ourselves; how we choose to live our lives; and how do we respond to the grace of God when it appears in forms different from our perceptions. A handout with scriptural references will be provided for personal reflection.
